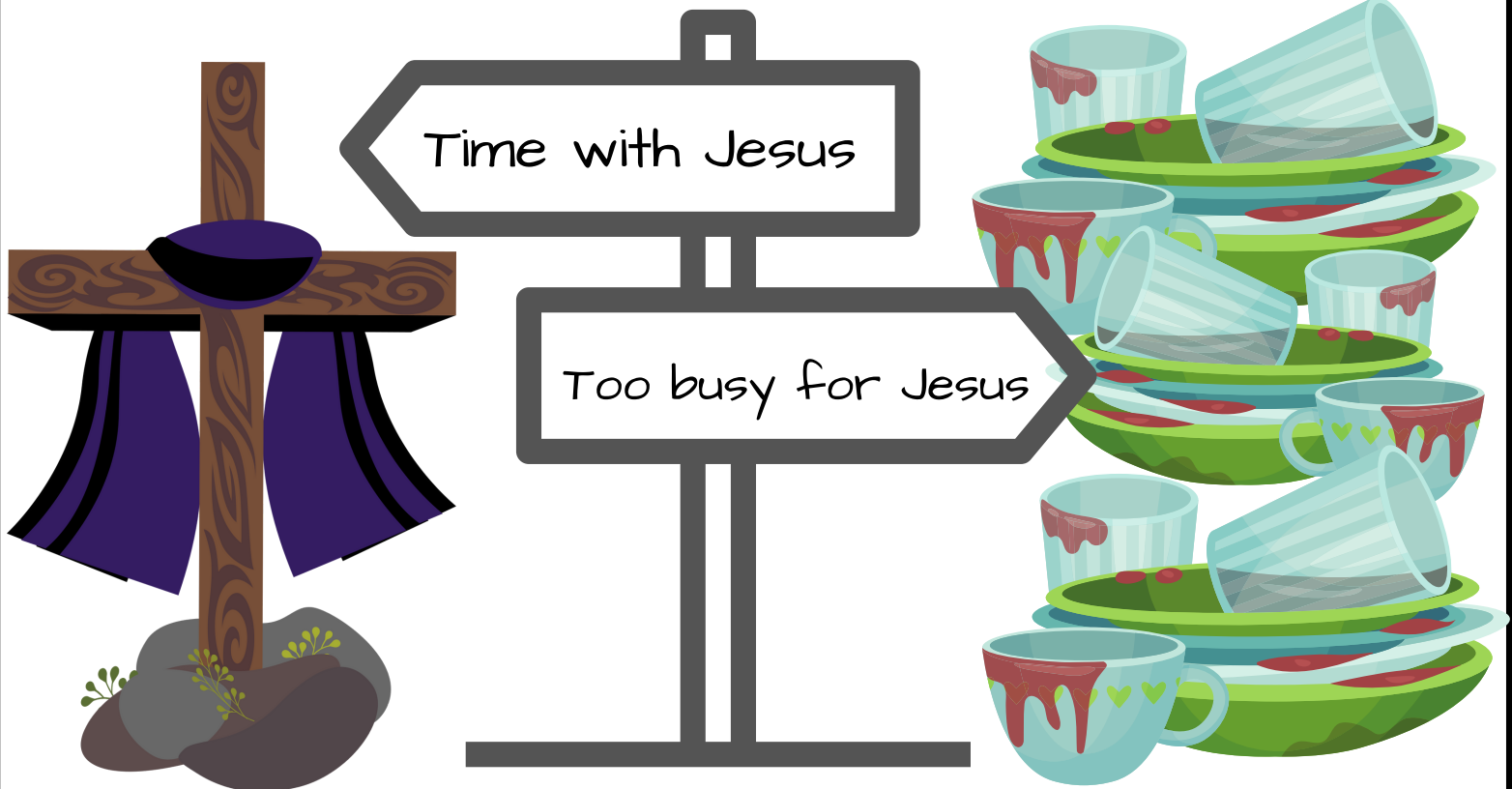


NEW TESTAMENT STORIES
