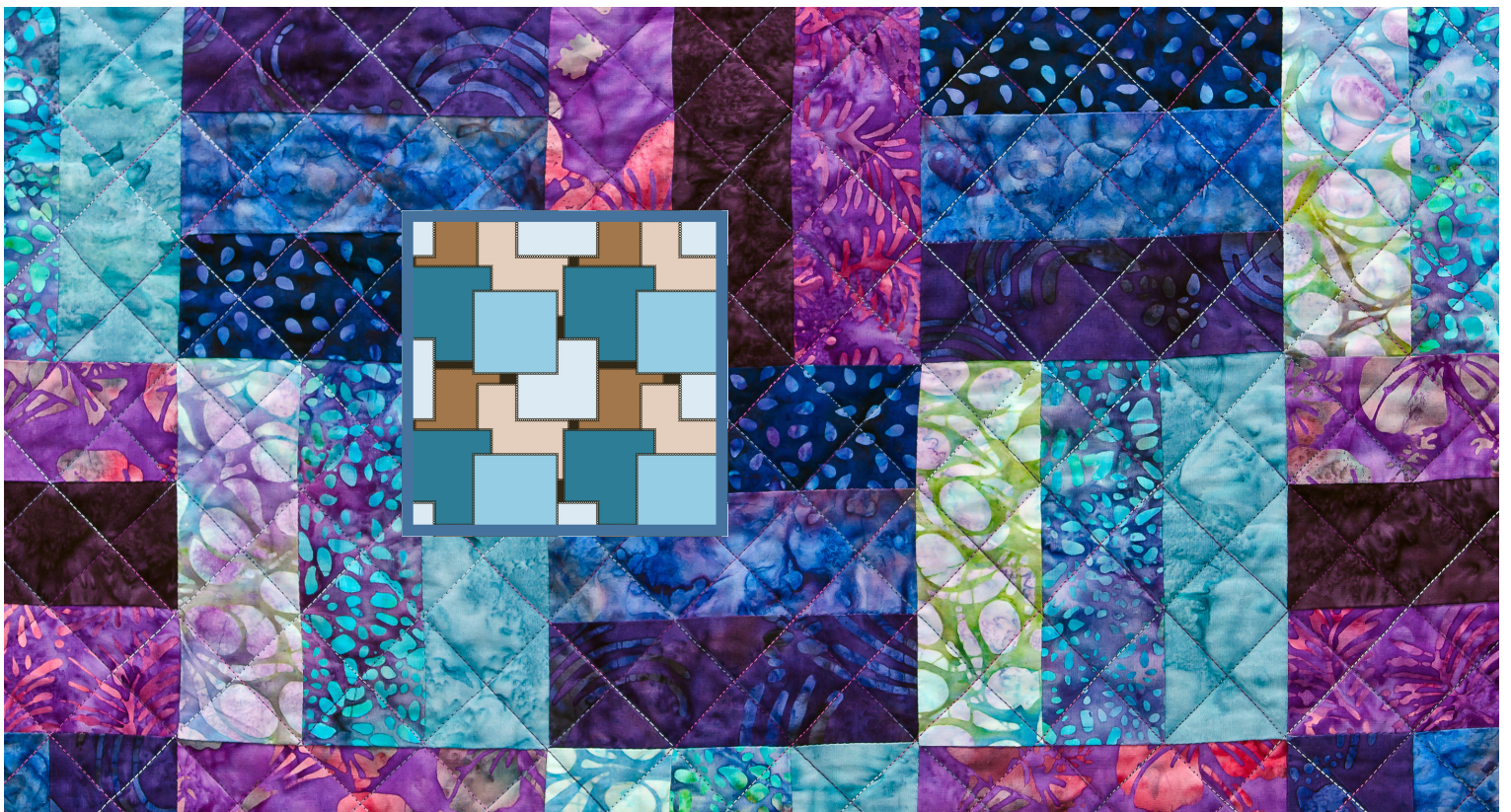


PARABLES OF JESUS

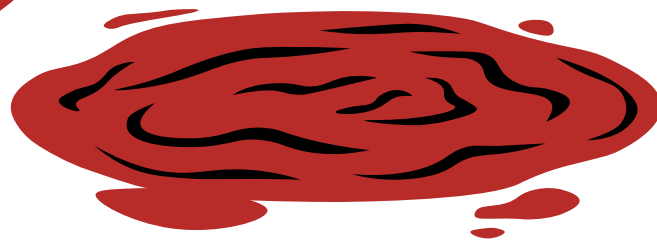
